






# SYRIZA IS AHEAD IN EURO ELECTIONS



# SOME THOUGHTS ON THE OUTCOME

- The regional and municipal elections on the 18<sup>th</sup> will definitely set the tone for the Euro Elections of the 25<sup>th</sup>.
- In regional elections SYRIZA is not expected to perform well and in most regions will not participate in the second round.
- In Euro Elections on the 25<sup>th</sup> a protest vote may give an edge to SYRIZA.
- Overall we do not expect a clear message against the coalition government although the level of undecided voters cannot preclude a surprise result.
- Based on the above our current estimates are:
  - New Democracy: **25%-26%**
  - SYRIZA: **27-28%**
  - ELIA PASOK: **5.5%-7%**
