

## **LATEST OPINION POLL ON REFERENDUM**

The latest poll from ALCO published in ETHNOS newspaper indicates that the Greeks are overwhelmingly in favour of the euro with 74% but in the referendum YES comes first with a small lead of 1.4%. According to survey data, the "YES" vote is 44.8% and the "NO" 43.4%. The undecided vote is 11.8%. Furthermore, 61% of the respondents believe that the "NO" vote risks exit from the Eurozone.

The YES vote shows a clear upward trend.

In other unpublished opinion polls the YES vote is ahead by nearly 5% although predictions about the actual outcome are difficult to make as Greeks are in desperate situation and new measures threaten the survival of another 15-20% of the population. As already 30% of unemployed and bankrupt small businessmen are solidly behind the NO vote it is no surprise that this position is resilient despite the failure of SYRIZA government and the collapse of the standing of Mr. Tsipras.

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
